Question: 5

You are performing a 4-point Overwrite Edit and have marked In and Out points in both the Source Monitor and Program Monitor. You want the Fit Clip dialog to open so you can perform a Fit-to-Fill edit but you previously set the Fit Clip dialog to always ignore the source out point. How can you get the Fit Clip dialog to open again so you can perform a Fit-to-Fill Edit?

- A. In Preferences > Timeline, check Fit Clip Dialog Opens for Edit Range Mismatches- Perform Overwrite Edit
- B. In the Timeline panel menu check Fit to Fill Opens for Edit Range Mismatches, and perform Overwrite Edit
- C. In Preferences > Trim tab. check Fit Clip Dialog Opens for Edit Range Mismatches. Restart Premiere Pro and perform Overwrite Edit.
- D. Map a keyboard shortcut for Fit-to-Fill. Mark In and Out points in Source and Program Monitors- and press Overwrite.
